1. INTRODUCTION

Parle Tilak Vidyalaya Association (PTVA) was established in 1921 to commemorate Lokmanya Tilak by starting with a Marathi medium school in Vile Parle, a distant suburb of Bombay, now Mumbai, initially with only 4 students. For more than 100 years, the Institution has grown into a reputed large educational organisation with four Primary Schools, four Secondary Schools, and one ICSE school. The Institution also has to its credit three Junior Colleges, three Degree Colleges affiliated to University of Mumbai with Under Graduate, Post Graduate Courses along with Research Centre for Ph.D. The institute also runs an AICTE approved Institute of Management offering Post Graduate Diploma and Degree courses in Management. At present nearly 26,000 students benefit from the altruism of the Institution.





Carry Forward of Marks:

Carry forward of marks in case of a learner who fails in the Internal Assessment and/or Semester End Assessment and/or Practical Assessment in one or more courses (subjects):

- A learner who FAILS in one or more components (Internal Assessment / Semester End Examination / Practical Examination) of the course shall reappear for that component of that course. However, his/her marks of the components in which he/she has passed shall be carried forward.

A.T.K.T. (ALLOWED TO KEEP TERMS)

Norms for A.T.K.T. under autonomy will be shortly updated on the college website.



ADDITIONAL EXAMINATION:

Internal Assessment (Wherever Applicable) and External Assessment (All SY Classes):

Eligibility norms to appear for the additional class test or assignment or project for learners who have remained absent:

- If a learner is absent on medical ground or for any reason / emergency beyond the control of the learner, the learner must apply to the Head of the Institution giving the reason(s) for absence within 8 days of the conduct of the examination along with the necessary documents and testimonials.
- If a learner is absent for participation in Inter Collegiate events, State or National or International level events, Training camp or coaching camp organized by authorized University or State or National or International Bodies, NSS / NCC Events / Camps / Cultural Activities / Sports Activities / Research or any other activities authenticated by the Head of the Institution, the Head of the Institution shall generally grant permission to the learner to appear for the additional class test or assignment.
- The Head of the Institution, on scrutiny of the documents and testimonials, may grant the permission to the learner to appear for the additional examination.
- Students are instructed to check the College Notice Board and with the College Office for the detailed schedule of fees, time table and procedures for the same.



5. DISCIPLINE AND CODE OF CONDUCT

DISCIPLINE

- Self-discipline is the best discipline. All students are expected to observe rules and regulations currently in force to enable the smooth working of the College.
- Students are prohibited from doing anything inside or outside the College that will interfere with its orderly administration or affect its public image. No outside influence, political or any other should be brought into the College directly or indirectly.
- Students resorting to unfair means at the examinations will be dealt in accordance with the provisions of Government of Maharashtra Act No. XXXI of 1982 and Maharashtra Universities Act 1994.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Students should always wear their valid College Identity card whenever in College or while representing the College at any other place. Further, it should be produced whenever demanded by any of the College staff.
- During the conduct of lectures, students should not loiter in the corridors or in and around the College premises.
- All students are expected to wear decent clothes to enhance the image of the College.
- While representing the College at any other place, the student's behaviour should not be detrimental to the image of the College.
- In case of any problem, personal or academic, students should report to the Co-ordinator / Vice-Principal / Principal.
- Students are directed not to bring any outsider into the College premises.
- Students must attend lectures according to the time-table on all working days of the College. Students must not be absent from lectures and examinations without the prior permission of the Principal. Students are warned that, if their attendance at lectures is unsatisfactory, their names will not be kept on the College roll.
- In case of illness, a student must apply for leave by post as soon as possible with doctor's certificate attached to his/her application and must report to the Principal immediately after resuming the College.
- Students must not attend classes other than their own without the permission of the Principal.
- Conduct of students in the classes as well as on the premises of the College shall be such as will cause no disturbance to fellow-students and to the other classes.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited in the College premises.
- Students shall do nothing either inside or outside the College that will in any way interfere with its orderly administration and discipline.
- No society or association shall be formed in the College and no person shall be invited to address a meeting without Principal's prior written permission.
- No students shall collect any money or contribution for picnic, trip educational visit to some place, get-together, study-notes, charity or any other activity without prior written permission of the Principal.
- In College debates and other meetings, the Chair must be taken by responsible person approved by Principal and the subject of the debate must have the prior approval of the Principal.
- No students will be allowed to take active part in current politics.



- College has surveillance of CCTV cameras on the entire premises excluding washrooms.
- No student shall communicate any information to or write about matters dealing with College administration to the media.
- Students are expected to take proper care of the College property and help to keep premises neat and tidy. Causing damage to the property of College, e.g. disfiguring walls, door, fitting and breaking furniture etc. is a breach of discipline and the guilty person(s) will be duly punished and shall compensate for the same.
- Students should not leave their books, valuables and other belongings in the class room for any reason. They are advised to carry the same, whenever they leave their classrooms.
- The College is not responsible for lost property. Students should deposit the property found by them at the office counter. The owner should claim it after due identification at the office counter.
- Students applying for certificates, testimonials etc. and those requiring the Principal's signature on any document or application should first contact the College office. No papers should be brought by students directly to the Principal for his/her signature.
- Vehicles i.e. Cars, Two wheelers, cycles brought by the students shall be parked at the student's risk in the place provided for the purpose. The College is not responsible for any damage to or theft of the vehicles.
- If, for any reason, the continuance of a student in the College is in the opinion of the Principal, detrimental to the interest of the College, the Principal may ask such a student to leave the College without giving any reason, and opinion of the Principal in this respect will be final and binding.
- Students joining the College are by that very fact supposed to accept and observe all the rules and regulations of the College and to undertake to submit the normal enforcement of the same to the satisfaction of the Principal whose decision in this regard shall be final.
- Matters not covered by existing rules will rest at the absolute discretion of the Principal.

RAGGING PROHIBITED

Government of Maharashtra has notified ragging as a cognizable offence. Anyone reported to be involved in any act of ragging, will be severely dealt with. Therefore, students are required to refrain from indulging in any form of ragging.

MOBILE PHONES PROHIBITED

As per the circular received from the University, the students should refrain themselves from using the mobile phone in the College premises. If any student is found using the mobile anywhere on the College premises (except in the designated areas) the mobile phone will be confiscated and student will be fined.



6. ATTENDANCE AND GRANT OF TERMS

DEGREE COLLEGE (ORDINANCE 119 & ORDINANCE 120)

Attendance of students is regulated by O.119, O.120 and 1.125. The explanation issued by the University vide circular No. UG/235/98 dated 3 17/98 relating to O.119 says that “For granting of terms, attendance of 75% of theory, practical and tutorials (wherever prescribed separately will be required, out of the total number of lectures, practical and tutorials conducted in the term.”

7. LIBRARY

Our College library is one of the best libraries in the suburbs. It plays a positive role as an essential component of learning.

Student Aid Fund (SAF):

This is a College fund through which students of all classes of under-graduate programmes are given a set of 30 books for a period of one year. This scheme can be availed by Open, OBC and NT category student having income below Rs 2,00,000/- per annum. The applicant must submit Annual Income Certificate and Caste Certificate at the time of applying for SAF.

Book Bank Scheme:

This scheme is run through University of Mumbai. Through this scheme students of all classes of under-graduate programmes are given a set of 30 books each. This scheme is applicable only to SC and ST students.



Financial Assistance to Needy and Financially Backward Class

This scheme is run by University of Mumbai. 5 students having good academic record, annual income not more than 1 lac and not more than 25 years of age is eligible for the Scheme.

Financial Assistance to ST Students

This scheme is run by University of Mumbai. This scheme is introduced only for students of the College belonging to ST category, having annual income not more than 1 lac and not more than 25 years of age.

Gold Card:

It is a Special Library Membership card issued only to the top rank holders of each class, which enables them to borrow an additional book from the College Library besides the regular one book that could be borrowed with the help of a regular card.

8. STUDENT WELFARE SCHEMES

GYMKHANA:

The College Gymkhana committee works on a mandate of helping to create well-groomed individuals out of students. To that end, the College has a state-of-the-art Gymkhana and Gymnasium with modern exercise and sports facilities. M.L. Dahanukar College ranks among the top 10 Colleges in University of Mumbai in sports.

COMPUTER LAB:

Students of the College have free of cost access to a fully equipped internet enabled computer laboratory. The laboratory has a computer lab attendant and is open from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The lab is regularly used by students for research and informational purposes helping them in their internal assignment and studies.

RESEARCH CELL:

The College has a fully functional Research Cell that guides and inspires students to undertake research and also to write and present their research papers at various National and International Conferences.

CANTEEN:

Our College has an open air hygienic canteen that offers food at nominal rates to students and Staff.

LANGUAGE LAB:

Our College has a computer based Language Laboratory on the third floor of the College building. Having a capacity of 25 mentees and a mentor console, the Language Lab software caters to the inculcation of learners' English language, soft skills and professional skills. The Audio-visual study material of the language lab is available for learners at Basic, Intermediary, Advanced and Professional level. The Language Lab also has basic level study material of Foreign Languages such as German and French.



COMMERCIAL LAB:

The aim of Commercial Lab is to bridge the gap between academics and corporate world. To achieve this, the Lab organizes various guest lectures, workshops and educational trips.

INCUBATION CELL

Considering Indian Entrepreneurship Spirit and ideas, passion and enthusiasm of Young Indian Entrepreneur's to start businesses on their own, Incubation and Innovation Cell have following objectives

- To identify, nurture and groom the business ideas of College students by providing them necessary mentoring, infrastructural and investment support.
- To encourage entrepreneurship among students through conducting seminars, workshops and competitions.

So far Cell has successfully incubated Book Share India, a social startup which uses modern technology and innovation to facilitate book donation and sharing.

COLLEGE FESTIVAL (Kurukshetra)

Students of ML Dahanukar College are encouraged to participate and organize intercollegiate festivals in areas of Music, Games, Sports, Culture, Co-Curricular.

STUDENT COUNSELLING:

The College has free counseling facility for Bonafide students of all streams by a Professional Counselor. The Counseling is available on Thursday from 9.00 am. to 1.00 pm.

12. If the student has passed the exam. at 2nd attempt, affidavit for gap period and is required. Income certificate of the year 2024-2025.
13. Bank Aadhaar seeding with NPCI mapping form to be downloaded from www.mahadbtmahait.gov.in. for the Bank where account for Freeship /Scholarship has been opened and then get the form stamped from the bank and submit the copy in the college office.



शिष्यवृत्ती व फ्रीशिप योजनांसाठी आवश्यक कागदपत्रे आणि सूचना

- उत्पन्नाचा दाखला काढताना तो कुटुंब प्रमुखाच्या नावाने असावा. यामध्ये वडील, आई, मोठा भाऊ, मोठी बहीण इत्यादी सर्व कुटुंबीयांचे एकत्रित वार्षिक उत्पन्न स्पष्टपणे नमूद करावे आणि प्रत्यक्षातील खरे उत्पन्नच दाखवावे.
- प्रवेशाच्या वेळी ज्या विद्यार्थ्यांना फी सवलत (Fee Concession) दिली जाते, त्यांनी स्कॉलरशिप व फ्रीशिपचे फॉर्म वेळेत भरले नाहीत, तर संपूर्ण वर्षाची फी भरावी लागेल. याची विद्यार्थ्यांनी व पालकांनी नोंद घ्यावी.
- विद्यार्थ्यांनी नोटीस व सूचनांचे काळजीपूर्वक वाचन करावे. वेळोवेळी कार्यालयात येऊन कोणतीही अडचण असल्यास समक्ष मार्गदर्शन घेणे आवश्यक आहे.
- स्कॉलरशिप व फ्रीशिपचे फॉर्म ऑनलाईन भरणे आवश्यक आहे. फॉर्म भरण्याची तारीख महाराष्ट्र शासनाच्या अधिकृत वेबसाइटवर दिलेली असते. नमूद कालावधीनंतर आलेले फॉर्म स्वीकारले जाणार नाहीत. याची विद्यार्थ्यांनी व पालकांनी नोंद घ्यावी.
- विद्यार्थ्यांची हजेरी किमान ७५% हून अधिक असणे अनिवार्य आहे.
- फॉर्म ऑनलाईन भरल्यानंतर त्यामध्ये सूचनांनुसार माहिती अचूकपणे भरणे आवश्यक आहे. चुकीची माहिती भरल्यास फॉर्म रद्द केला जाऊ शकतो किंवा फीची रक्कम कमी मिळू शकते. अशा परिस्थितीत संपूर्ण जबाबदारी विद्यार्थ्यांची असेल.
- ज्यांनी मागील शैक्षणिक वर्षात शिक्षणात गॅप घेतला असेल किंवा इतर समकक्ष कोर्सला स्कॉलरशिप घेतली असेल, अशा विद्यार्थ्यांना पुन्हा समकक्ष पदवीसाठी सरकारी अनुदान (grant) मिळत नाही. त्यामुळे अशा परिस्थितीत विद्यार्थ्यांना संपूर्ण फी भरावी लागेल. याची नोंद घ्यावी.
- शासनाच्या धोरणानुसार स्कॉलरशिप व फ्रीशिपच्या नियमांमध्ये बदल होण्याची शक्यता असते. त्यामुळे स्कॉलरशिप व फ्रीशिप देणे हे पूर्णपणे शासनाच्या निर्णयावर अवलंबून आहे.
- विभागामार्फत अर्ज मंजूर झाल्यानंतर वेबसाइटवरील “Redeem Status” मध्ये दिसणारी फी ग्राह्य धरली जाईल. त्यानंतरची उर्वरित फी विद्यार्थ्यांनी स्वतः भरावी.
