


Recommend Box

A Wednesday! (2008) is a sharp, high-tension thriller written and directed by Neeraj Pandey. It follows Naseeruddin Shah as an anonymous “common man” who calls Commissioner Prakash Rathod (Anupam Kher) and threatens to trigger bombs across Mumbai if four terrorists aren’t released. Set between 2 PM and 6 PM on a single Wednesday, the film builds steady suspense as the police race to understand his real motive.

With strong support from Jimmy Sheirgill and Aamir Bashir, the film stands out for its crisp writing and emotional depth rather than big action. It highlights the frustration of an ordinary citizen and questions how justice works in a flawed system. **A Wednesday!** is available on Netflix.

Why you should watch it: It’s a gripping, intelligent thriller that stays tense without relying on spectacle. The moral dilemma is whether a common man can take matters into his own hands. It feels timeless, making the film both impactful and thought-provoking.

SCAMS

Delhi Cops Bust ₹170-Crore Fraud Ring

On 10 November 2025, Delhi Police exposed a ₹170-crore cyber-fraud network where a Delhi gang sold hundreds of Indian bank accounts to a Chinese crime syndicate. These accounts were created using fake identity documents or taken over from real users, then traded through encrypted Telegram channels. The scam surfaced after a victim lost ₹20 lakh in an online investment fraud. The racket was operated from a rented flat in Rohini by Saurabh Gupta, Indra Kumar, Mohit Kumar, and Nepalese national Bishal Shreshtha, who turned these accounts into mule accounts and earned a 2% commission paid through cryptocurrency. During the raid, police seized 36 smartphones, 26 basic phones, 43 SIM cards, 8 laptops, fake company stamps, ATM cards, passbooks and several forged identity documents. So far, 146 complaints from across India have been linked to this group. The case highlights how fake documents and mule accounts are increasingly being used for large-scale cross-border financial fraud.


Echoes of the RED FORT Blast

On 10 November 2025, the usual crowd near Red Fort Metro Gate 1 moved through their morning routine including tourists, students, office-goers. A white Hyundai i20 stood quietly by the road, drawing no attention.

Within seconds, everything changed. A massive explosion tore through the area, sending smoke into the air, shattering glass, and causing panic to sweep the street. Eight people lost their lives, and many more were injured as sirens filled the air.

Investigators soon confirmed what everyone feared: this was a terror attack, not an accident. The case was handed to the NIA, and the search led to a key suspect, Dr. Umar Mohammad, believed to be linked to a wider terror module.

Delhi tightened security, but the city also showed its strength. Strangers helped pull the injured to safety, and the historic walls of Red Fort once again witnessed both tragedy and courage.


